

## COOKIE POLICY

Pursuant to Article 13 EU Regulation 679/2016 (GDPR) and 8 Data Protection Authority Decision dtd. 8th May 2014, Copernit S.p.a. (hereinafter referred to as Copernit) provides the following information relating to cookies installed on the domain <http://www.copernit.it>.

### What are cookies?

Cookies are text strings created by a server and stored on the hard disk of the computer or any device used by the user to access the Internet (smartphone, tablet) and then retransmitted to the Internet during the subsequent user's access.

Cookies allow you to collect information on the browsing made by the user on the website.

Cookies can be stored permanently on your computer and have a variable duration (so-called persistent cookies), but they can also vanish when the browser is closed or have a limited duration (so-called session cookies).

Cookies can be installed by the site you are visiting (so-called first-party cookies) or can be installed by other websites that provide services of various kinds (so-called third-party cookies).

### How does Copernit use cookies?

#### *Technical cookies and session cookies*

These cookies are essential to browsing throughout the site and to the use of all its features, such as filling out a contact form, newsletter subscription form, user registration form or the ability to remember your login credentials access. Without these cookies, some necessary services cannot be used.

#### *Analytical Cookies*

These cookies collect statistical information on how users use the website, for example which pages are most visited, or the geographical location from which the visitors come. By using the website you agree that these cookies can be stored on your device. These cookies are installed using the Google Analytics platform that detect the user's IP address "in the clear".

Google Analytics can cross the data collected through our site with others in its possession to profile the visitor and offer targeted advertising to its consumption habits or preferences.

#### *Third-Party Cookies*

Our site uses Social features and this is why consent is required for the installation of cookies coming from:

- Sharethis: web platform that allows you to share, enter a "like" or comments on the content on this site. The Social Network could use the information collected to create user behavioural profiles to be used for commercial purposes for advertising campaigns. - Google Maps: provides interactive maps that allow Copernite to include customizable maps within its web pages. Our site uses Google Maps to provide detailed information on the location of our headquarters. ### How to change and manage cookie settings?

At the time of access to the Site Home Page, there is a banner that contains a brief privacy policy. By closing the banner and continuing browsing, you consent to the use of cookies.

The consent to the use of cookies is registered with a "technical cookie".

You can also oppose the recording of cookies on your hard drive by configuring your browser to disable cookies. The following are the methods provided by the major browsers:

### **Data sharing and disclosure**

The data collected using cookies may be shared with companies that manage the services listed above. These companies are to be considered independent data controllers.

Some of the companies that manage the information collected via cookies have their headquarters in countries outside the EU, data is transferred according to the agreement between EU-US Privacy Shield.

The data collected using cookies will not be disclosed.
